Answer: Thanks for calling. Unfortunately, we can't release information about our associate to anyone other than the associate. Your wife is more than welcome to call the branch if she needs to know her schedule, and we are happy to assist!

Question: What clients do you send people to?

Answer: Hi, thank you for your interest in Elwood Staffing! Have you applied with us before? If not, that is the first step in our hiring process. Once you have applied, we will review your application to see if we have any positions that meet your skill set. *IMPORTANT NOTE: Do not give out client's names over the phone.*

Question: How do I get paid?
